- ✓ Track social media engagement to identify high-performing ideas and campaigns for scalability across multiple platforms including Twitter®, Instagram®, YouTube®, Facebook®, and TikTok®
- ✓ Develop social media content for GPHL's current social media accounts on Twitter®, Instagram®, Facebook®, and YouTube®, including managing social media content and designing compelling and visually appealing graphics
- ✓ Write and edit content highlighting GPHL's activities, success stories, achievements and needs for a variety of audiences through blogs, vlogs and all current and future GPHL social media accounts
- ✓ Work with the GPHL/MFSI Database team through their weekly Zoom meetings to review and analyze demographic data and program data to produce summary graphics (pie charts, bar graphs, line graphs and area graphs) for the GPHL 2020 Annual Report
